Dear Facility Security Officer:

This letter provides updated information regarding the Seafarer Welfare and Labor Organizations that serve mariners in our area. In order to assist in identifying these advocates, an updated list of Seafarer Welfare Organization Representatives is enclosed. This list may be used to validate information provided by persons wishing to gain access to your facility in support of Seafarer Welfare Organizations.

As a reminder, regulations in Title 33 Code of Federal Regulations 105.237(b) (3) require regulated facilities to coordinate access through the facility for representatives of Seafarer Welfare and Labor Organizations. Impeding the ability of these individuals to access the vessels at your facility conflicts with the regulation cited above. All of the individuals listed on the enclosure hold a valid Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC). I greatly appreciate your continued support in ensuring representatives of Seafarer Welfare and Labor Organizations are afforded access to vessels at your facility.
