

Seafarers' Access to Maritime Facilities

Information and guidance for vessels arriving in the Sector New Orleans AOR.

On January 8, 2024, Sector New Orleans published Marine Safety Information Bulletin (MSIB) XXIV-004. This MSIB specified requirements of facilities regarding Seafarers' Access. In addition, "best work practices" were provided to streamline the process for both Facilities and Vessels.

In accordance with the MSIB, Sector New Orleans recommends the following of vessels arriving in the Sector New Orleans AOR:

- Vessels arriving in the Lower Mississippi River shall make every effort to communicate intentions for Seafarers' Access when calling on MTSA regulated facilities.
- Provide the following information to the facility to help with timely shore access:
 - a. Contact name and phone number to arrange access
 - b. Length of time vessel is scheduled to be in port, and
 - Best estimates of times and number of crew members seeking shore access.
